

FUNDING REGULATIONS

- 1. There is no legal claim to a scholarship.
- 2. A current registration at the JKU is mandatory to receive a scholarship. A leave of absence is not permitted.
- 3. Any other financial support or funding must be reported to the International Office without exception and could lead to a reduction of the scholarship amount. Failure to do so will lead to cancellation of the scholarship.
- 4. The scholarship holder is obliged to inform the International Office about any gratuities, in particular if these are associated with expectations of compensating measures from the JKU, e.g. in favor of students from partner universities for their studies in Linz.
- 5. Scholarship holders are obliged to pursue their studies on a regular basis and to be present at the study location abroad.
- 6. Any part-time job during the subsidized stay abroad has to be reported and can lead to a reduction of the scholarship amount. It is only permitted if it does not affect the realization of the study or research objectives.
- 7. Any proven violation of the rules at the host university (e.g. use of unauthorized aids in examinations) will result in the cancellation of the scholarship.
- 8. Purpose-related use of the scholarship has to be proven within 2 months after the end of the funding period. In order to do so, the following two forms must be completed: "Exchange Programs: Study Abroad Report" and "Exchange Programs: Transcript Upload and Feedback"
- 9. Recognition of a minimum of 3 ECTS credits per scholarship month is required.
- 10. Original receipts (invoices) for additional costs must be submitted to the International Office in case of extra benefits for special needs.
- 11. The total scholarship or part of it might be subject to refund in case of non purpose-related use, use during invalid time period, violation of the funding regulations or ineligible receipt of the scholarship. The scholarship or part of it might also be subject to refund in case of additional funding.
- 12. Any violation to the funding regulations will result in ineligibility for participation in any exchange program of the JKU and for any JKU scholarship.
- 13. The scholarship or travel expense allowance does not include insurance. The JKU does not carry any liability. The students shall carry the responsibility for sufficient insurance cover for the stay abroad.
